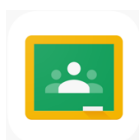
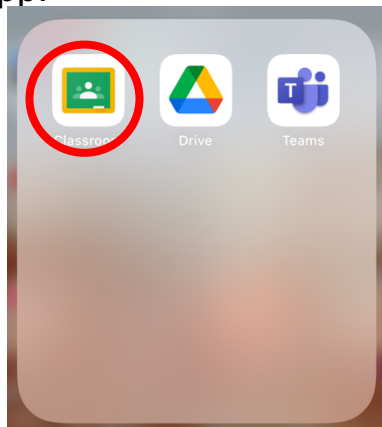


How to access Google Classroom on a mobile device or tablet

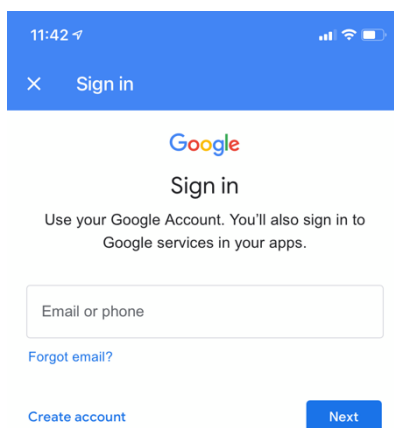


Make sure you have downloaded the Google Classroom app.

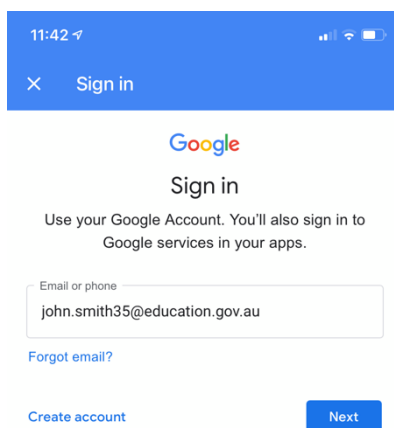
1. Open the Google Classroom app.



2. If you have not signed into the app before, it will take you to a sign in page.



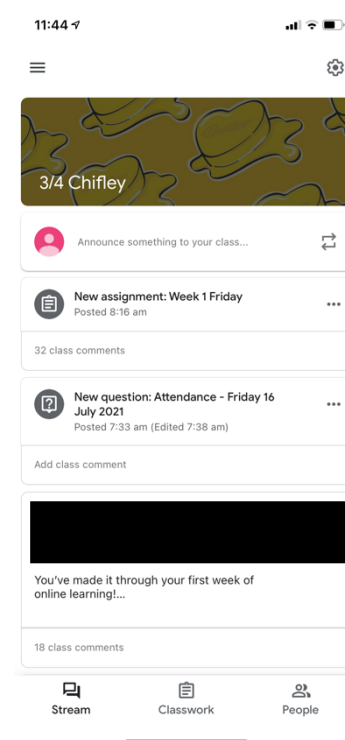
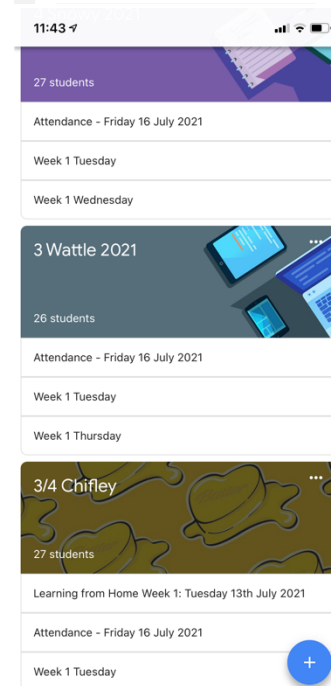
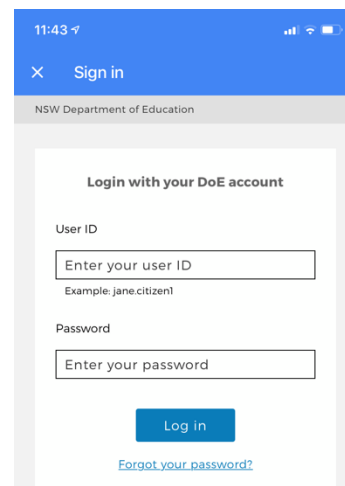
3. Enter the student login that is used on the computers at school. Some students may have a number with their login.



4. Press 'next'. It will then take you to the DoE sign in page. Your user ID is the login that you use at school to use the computers. Your password is your class name this year. Then click 'log in'.

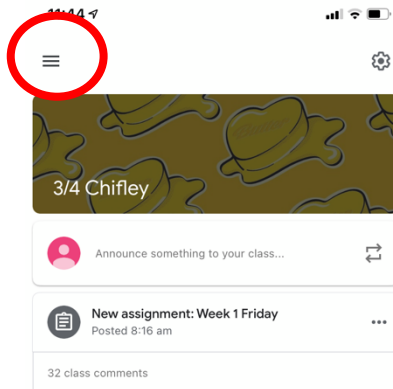
5. If you have accessed Google Classroom in class and you are a member of the Classroom, your class will pop up on the screen.

6. Click on your class to see your classwork.

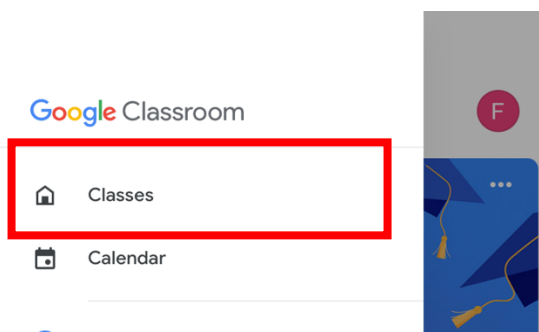


How to access Google Classroom on a mobile device or tablet that has multiple accounts.

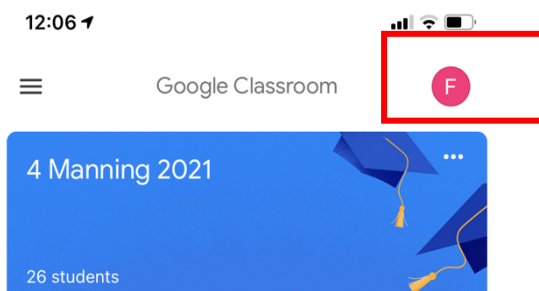
1. If there are multiple accounts on the Google Classroom app, click on the icon with the 3 horizontal lines at the top left hand corner.



2. Click on 'classes'.



3. Click on the round icon at the top right-hand corner.



4. Click on 'add another account' if that account has not used the device before. If an account has used that device before, click on 'manage accounts on this device'.
